## TREATMENT

MIAMI 13 is a feature length romantic comedy about a series of bad events being experienced by several men. But for one of these men (viz. Peter Dantz), it turned out to be his luckiest day. For Peter, this was supposed to be the happiest day of his life, and nothing was to go wrong. But, that wasn't the case. He was to get promoted to an executive position and then he was going to propose to his long time girlfriend (Saana). However, what happened was not at all what Peter expected. From the moment, he woke up, a series of bad things begin to happen.

First, he walks out of his apartment building, is mistaken for a drug dealer and nearly robbed. A few feet away in his apartment community, drives up and witnesses a man beating a police officer. The overpowered uniform police officer in distress asked for his help and Peter refuses. But the situation gets worse for him when several detectives arrive on the scene to assist the uniformed police officer.

Later we see a couple consisting of Manny (A struggling actor) and his girlfriend Johanna (A very attractive model-like and extremely jealous woman) in a heated argument shouting and scolding Manny for cheating on her and spending money on another pretty model-like woman (Jenny) when he is supposed to be broke. Enraged by the argument, Manny steps out of Johanna's car and begins walking. During his walk, Manny decides to rob a gas station to fulfill his girlfriend's needs for money. Meanwhile, Peter realizes that he is almost out of gas and decides to stop at a gas station to fill up. Unbeknown to him, this was the time when Manny was

robbing the gas station to get money for his Johanna. After robbing the gas station, Manny does a quick getaway by foot and accidentally bumps into a young hoodlum near a bus stop. Manny and the young hoodlum get into a confrontation and eventually the hoodlum backs down and runs away. Soon after, Manny sees an approaching bus and get in the bus. In the bus, a con man (Santiago) sitting way in the back of the bus stands up and begins to hassle the passenger for money. He approaches Manny, and begs for money not knowing that Manny had a lot of money on him.

Santiago begins to harass the other passengers for money and the bus driver chases him off the bus. A few blocks away, Manny gets of the bus, walks pass a small park and sits at a bench next to a man playing the conga. Distraught and hungry, he still decides to go inside the restaurant to have lunch. However, while in the restaurant, he accidentally splits his pants right in the middle without him knowing. Sometime later, while eating, Peter notices an attractive woman staring at him. They make long eye contacts and they both continue to flirt with each other so peter thought. By some coincidence, at an adjoining table was, the little girl (Chassidy) with her mother (Tori) and the sorority sisters having lunch.

He proposes a deal to Teejay offering him to borrow his pants for \$150 and leaving his Rolex watch as collateral for an hour.
